## About the Depot

The Pennsy Depot is a rehabilitation of the original building. On December 25, 1871, the first passenger train puffed its way into Decatur, when the Grand Rapids & Indiana (G R & I) became Adams County's first railroad. The Depot was built circa 1892 when the Penn Central railroad took over the GR & I lines, and the depot became known as the Pennsy Station. A local effort to restore the depot has led to the property as it stands today, and soon to be listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

## Rental notes and numbers

### How much to rent the Depot?

Rental is \$25 per hour, with a minimum of two hours. A \$100 deposit is required.

### How big is the Depot?

The Depot can accommodate 49 guests. There are six 60" round tables, one 6' banquet table and 48 folding chairs.

### Are there kitchen facilities?

The kitchen includes a full-size refrigerator and coffee maker; there is no stove or microwave. There is a long counter with multiple plug-ins for warming devices. Also, there is a separate caterer's entrance that enters into the kitchen, so your guests aren't disturbed.

### Decorating dos and don'ts

You are welcome to decorate tables to personalize your event. You are **not** permitted to attach decorations to walls, doors, windows or the ceiling. We think you will find the Depot's restoration a charming spot on its own for your event.

### Is alcohol permitted in the Depot?

If you would like to serve alcohol at your event, you must make the request in your rental agreement; permission is subject to approval.
